

## **ARTICLE 23 - EMERGENCY ASSIGNMENTS**

### **A. BASE STAFFING EMERGENCY**

1. At any time during a contractual month, if the projected open time for the balance of that month apparently exceeds projected utilization, the Company may temporarily use supervisors to relieve such shortage. However, such supervisors shall be used in accordance with the Order of Open Time Coverage in Article 9.L. Such action shall be considered a base staffing emergency.

2. The APFA Scheduling Coordinator shall be notified when supervisors are being utilized during a base staffing emergency.

### **B. OTHER ASSIGNMENTS**

1. The Company may temporarily assign an employee not covered by this Agreement to perform Flight Attendant duties when regular Flight Attendants are not available.

2. A Flight Attendant supervisor, during the course of an observation ride or any other time a supervisor is onboard a flight (except when assigned to work as Flight Attendant), will not perform Flight Attendant duties, except in cases of emergency.<sup>1</sup>
