Dear Laura:

This letter supplements the December 31, 2012 letter (the "MOU") concerning the Conditional Labor Agreement between US Airways ("US") and the Association of Professional Flight Attendants ("APFA") dated April 12, 2012 (the "CLA") entered into in connection with the consideration of a potential merger between US and American Airlines ("American"). US and APFA acknowledge and agree that the term "Current FAs" as used in the CLA means Flight Attendants who were on the American seniority list as of the date of the CLA – April 12, 2012 – who are still on the American seniority list on the Plan Effective Date (defined in the CLA as the effective date of the Plan of Reorganization) and the term "New Hires" as used in the CLA and in the MOU means Flight Attendants whose employment at American commences after April 12, 2012.


