RE: Reserve Sick Charge for LUS

Dear Laura:

This letter will confirm our understanding and agreement regarding a Reserve sick charge for LUS Flight Attendants under Section 9.2., of the LUS/AFA Collective Bargaining Agreement. Daily Scheduling will determine if a Reserve Flight Attendant would have been utilized based on the following criteria:

At this time, ROTA will not consider sick utilization for Future processing and all proposed changes will occur in CATS.

- 1) If the Flight Attendant has not been awarded or assigned a trip sequence or OPR, Daily Scheduling will determine if the Flight Attendant would have been utilized for either a trip sequence or OPR based on the following:
 - The trip sequence will be based on days of availability by the click count and inverse seniority
 - The OPR will be based on OPR click count and inverse seniority
 - If Daily Scheduling has already assigned a trip sequence, but the Flight Attendant has not been notified, the Flight Attendant will be marked as utilized for the entire trip sequence.
 - Language of Destination/Origination (LOD/O) Flight Attendants will only be considered after processing all non-LOD/O Flight Attendants.
 - If the Flight Attendant is not assigned a Reserve Availability Period (RAP) during Reserve Open Time Assignment (ROTA), no RAP will be considered in the sick utilization process.
 - If the Flight Attendant was assigned a RAP in ROTA processing, the RAP will not be considered in the sick utilization process.

- 2) If a Flight Attendant has already been awarded or assigned a trip sequence or On Premise Reserve (OPR), she/he will be shown as utilized for the value of the entire trip sequence or OPR and charged sick for each day of the trip sequence.


