

# Red Flag Pairings and the UBL

---

## Overview

In the LUS 2013 CBA, some differences exist between the rules applicable to the UBL award processing of regular pairings (non-RF) and the rules that are utilized for Red Flag (RF) pairings. Pairings are Red Flagged during times of short coverage to protect the operation. Currently ISAP is not programmed to handle Red Flagged pairings; therefore, Red Flag pairings will be designated and processed via the UBL and Daily processes.

**Note:** The Joint Collective Bargaining Agreement (JCBA) RF pairing pay rates are in effect. As a result, a Red Flagged pairing is paid at one hundred and fifty percent (150%) and credited at one hundred percent (100%).

---

## L/H RF Pairing Bidding Criteria

**Transaction within a “Single Bid Month”:** The following criteria apply to a L/H bidding for RF pairings.

- 1.) P/U (pick-up) on Non-Flying Days: A L/H on non-flying days who are requesting to pick-up a RF pairing/position and cannot exceed her/his monthly MAX or go below the MIN of 40 hours.
- 2.) P/U and Drop transaction: The net result of a P/U and Drop transaction when a L/H picks-up a RF pairing and drops a line pairing cannot exceed her/his MAX or go below the MIN of 40 hours. In most cases, a transaction can only have one dropped pairing. Refer to example 6 for an awarded transaction that contains more than one pairing and example 9 for a denied transaction.
- 3.) RF UBL Important Rules and Conditions: The following applies to all UBL P/U and Drop transactions being awarded:
  - ✓ **Date of Origination:**  
A L/H can't drop her/his line pairing to originate a RF pairing if it originates on the same day. A dropped line pairing must originate on the day after the origination of the RF pairing or beyond.
  - ✓ **Daily and Monthly Limitations/Touching:**  
When picking-up a RF pairing that touches a line pairing, the F/A will be subject to the Monthly limits unless the bid is a neutral or positive transaction. If the F/A is picking up a RF pairing that doesn't touch a line pairing, and the F/A wants to drop a line pairing later in the month, she/he shall be subject to the Daily and Monthly limits.

## Red Flag Pairings and the UBL, Continued

---

### RF Pairings Bidding Criteria *cont.*

- ✓ **Holiday Restrictions:**

Holiday Daily Limits apply when a pairing being dropped contains a restricted Holiday duty period. Refer to page 10-27 of the LUS 2013 CBA.

    - If the RF pairing/position and the dropped line pairing both contain a DP touching the same restricted Holiday, such transaction will be considered Neutral for purposes of Holiday restrictions. In this instance, Neutral Holiday transactions will be awarded if all other RF bidding criteria are satisfied.
    - Conversely, if the restricted Holiday drop increases the open time limit on the restricted Holiday beyond the limit for such Holiday, the bid will be denied.
    - Refer to example 2 for an awarded transaction containing a restricted Holiday.
  
  - ✓ **Transaction must touch and contain a Neutral/Positive Result:**

Compare the number of calendar days in the pairing being picked up to the number of calendar days in the pairing being dropped. The result must be neutral/positive as shown in the categories below to be awarded:

    - Neutral: Dropping 4 calendar days to P/U 4 calendar days or Dropping 3 calendar days to P/U 3 calendar days or Dropping 2 calendar days to P/U 2 calendar days.
    - Positive: Dropping 1 calendar day to P/U 2 or more calendar days.
    - Negative: Dropping 4 calendar days to P/U 3 or less calendar days.
    - At Crew Scheduling's discretion they may allow a negative transaction to permit a F/A to pick up a RF pairing/position.
    - If TI pairings of longer duration, like 5 or 6 calendar days operate in the future, the same logic shown above applies.
  
  - ✓ **Overlap Conditions:**

Under the provisions of 2013 LUS CBA 10.H., Red Flag pairings shall not commence a duty period on more than one day of the original pairings requested to be dropped. As previously stated, ISAP is not programmed to accept RF pairings; therefore the UBL is utilized to cover Red Flag pairings for L/Hs. The examples below comply with the intent of the CBA language and the workaround UBL procedures.

## General Rules for All RF Transactions

---

### RF Rules and Information Applicable to All RF Examples

When reviewing the following RF Examples, keep in mind some additional rules and applicable important information:

- All FAR legalities must be satisfied.
- RPT: used for duty period Report Time.
- RLS: used for duty period Release Time.
- Most of the examples use a MAX of 95 hours. In actual operations, the MAX will vary depending on the activity of the participating L/H. Depending on the activity of the L/H, the logic shown in the examples applies to the transaction but with different results according to the specific bid.
- If a L/H's awarded transaction results in a loss of time; such loss is not required to be made-up.
- If a RF pairing/position is awarded that works on a compensated Holiday, the Holiday pay will be in addition to the applicable RF pay.
- Position selection relative to a RF pairing/position applies per the LUS 2013 CBA.
- If a trade occurs between a F/A holding a RF pairing/position and a F/A holding a non-RF pairing/position, the RF indicator/pay remains with the original RF pairing.
- Some UBL touches within a RF or non-RF transaction may have legal domicile rest and create a "multiple pairing combination". In those cases, Crew Scheduling will not assume such pairings that touch are to be dropped. Such decision belongs to the L/H and she/he must advise Crew Scheduling of her/his decision.
- Some UBL touches within a RF or non-RF transaction may create a legal "double-up". In those cases, Crew Scheduling will not assume such pairings that touch are to be dropped. Such decision belongs to the L/H and she/he must advise Crew Scheduling of her/his decision.

## P/U-Drop in a “Single Month”

**Example 1** Current Bid Month: 31AUG thru 30SEP  
**P/U-Drop** F/A Sally has 80 hrs. with a 95 MAX.

Scenario: Sally wants to P/U a RF pairing and drop a line pairing.

## P/U-Drop in a “Single Month”, Continued

**Example 2**  
**P/U-Drop with**  
**a Holiday**  
**Pairing**

Current Bid Month: 31AUG thru 30SEP

F/A Sammy is an ITA LOD/O and has 90 hrs. with a 115 MAX.

Scenario: Sammy wants to P/U a RF pairing and drop a line pairing.

**Note:** The P/U-Drop pairings both touch Labor Day (07SEP).

Crew Scheduling ensures Sammy’s bid does not violate the rules and conditions shown above in the bidding criteria. In this example, Sammy is awarded the RF pairing because the P/U-Drop does not originate on the same day, the transaction does not overlap (commence) on more than one day, the bid is neutral (P/U an RF3 in place of a 3 day line pairing), MAX of 115 is not exceeded and the Holiday restriction requirement is satisfied.</p> <p><b>Holiday Restriction:</b> Both pairings touch 07SEP. For the purposes of the Holiday restriction requirements, this P/U-Drop is considered neutral because the open pairing days on Labor Day are not increased beyond the limit for such Holiday.</p>			

**Important:**

The example above represents an Italian LOD/O, however the logic and application applies to non-LOD/O T/I, NTI and Domestic pairings as well.

**Note:** T/I P/U or Drop does not have to be for the same destination.

## P/U-Drop in a “Single Month”, Continued

### Example 3 P/U-Drop

Current Bid Month: 31AUG thru 30SEP  
F/A Jack has 75 hrs. with a 95 MAX.

Scenario: Jack wants to P/U a RF pairing and drop a line pairing. In this request the pairings do not touch.

(page 10-24). As a result, Jack’s bid is denied by Crew Scheduling.</p>

## P/U-Drop in a “Single Month”, Continued

**Example 4** Current Bid Month: 31AUG thru 30SEP  
**P/U-Drop** F/A Annie has 80 hrs. with a 95 MAX

Scenario: Annie “wants better”; she is holding a pairing originating on the same calendar day as the RF pairing she would like to P/U.

**Note:** UBL activity does not allow a L/H to be awarded a P/U-Drop transaction that originates on the same day. Ref. pg. 10-28 LUS 2013 CBA.

**Example 5** Current Bid Month: 31AUG thru 30SEP  
**P/U-Drop** F/A Sara has 80 hrs. with a 95 MAX.

Scenario: Sara wants to P/U a RF pairing and drop a line pairing resulting in a Negative transaction. Additionally, Sara’s bid involves overlapping/commencing on more than one day.

## P/U-Drop RF in a “Single Month”, Continued

### Example 6 P/U-Drop

Current Bid Month: 31AUG thru 30SEP  
F/A Cindy has 75 hrs. with a 95 MAX.

Scenario: Cindy wants to P/U a TI RF3 pairing and drop two (2) one (1)-day pairings in her line.

**Note:** In this request only one of the 1-day pairings creates an overlap related to the touch.

<b>Result: AWARDED</b>	<p>Cindy’s transaction illustrates an unusual touch because it involves two 1-day pairings. Crew Scheduling ensures Cindy’s bid does not violate the bidding criteria. Cindy is awarded the RF pairing because the P/U-Drop does not originate on the same day, the transaction does not overlap (commence) on more than one day, the bid is positive (P/U an RF3 in place of two 1-day line pairings). Additionally, Cindy did not exceed her MAX of 95.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> In many cases, a UBL transaction will only work by dropping one pairing because of the rule relating to not exceeding a one day overlap (commencing). However, when the RF pairing/position being picked up has a long duty break like on a Transatlantic pairing or certain red eye pairings, the transaction is awarded.</p> <p>Furthermore, if this same UBL transaction was submitted using Month to Month dates or a non-RF P/U and Drop(s) request, it would also be awarded.</p>			

## Allowable “Month to Month” Activity

---

### Month-to-Month RF Bidding Criteria

Allowable Month to Month UBL activity related to RF pairings:

1. On non-flying days that span two (2) bid months:
    - L/Hs who are requesting to P/U a RF pairing/position spanning to (2) bid months cannot exceed the monthly MAX in either month.
  2. P/U and Drop transactions:
    - RF P/U – pairing originates and releases in the current month. Drop a line pairing that originates in the current month and released in the next month.
    - RF P/U – pairing originates in the current month but releases in the next month. Drop a line pairing that originates in the current month and releases in the next month.
    - RF P/U – pairing originates in the current month but releases in the next month. Drop line pairing originates/ends in the next month.
    - In most cases, a transaction can only have one dropped pairing. Refer to example 6 for an awarded transaction that contains more than one pairing and example 9 for a denied transaction.
  3. P/U and Drop MAX and MIN Results:
    - ✓ RF P/U-Drop transactions that involve month to month activity cannot exceed the MAX or go below the MIN of 40 hours in either bid month.

## Rules for RF with “Month to Month” Activity

---

### L/H RF Rules Month to Month RF Criteria

These rules and conditions apply when picking-up RF pairing/position with month to month activity as outlined above in number 1 thru 3.

✓ **Date of origination:**

A L/H cannot drop her/his line pairing to originate a RF pairing if it originates on the same day. A dropped line pairing must originate on the day after the origination of the RF pairing or beyond.

✓ **Daily and Monthly Limitations/Touching:**

When picking-up a RF pairing/position that touches a line pairing, the F/A will be subject to the Monthly limits unless the bid is a neutral or positive transaction. If the F/A is picking up a RF pairing/position that doesn't touch the RF pairing and wants to drop a line pairing later in the month, she/he shall be subject to Daily and Monthly limits

✓ **Transaction must touch and contain a Neutral/Positive Result:**  
Compare the number of calendar days in each month of the pairing being picked up and the pairing being dropped. The result in each month must be neutral/positive as shown in the categories below to be awarded; refer to examples 7-8-9 for month to month duty period distribution scenarios.

- Neutral: Dropping 4 calendar days to P/U 4 calendar days or Dropping 3 calendar days to P/U 3 calendar days or Dropping 2 calendar days to P/U 2 calendar days.
- Positive: Dropping 1 calendar day to P/U 2 or more calendar days.
- Negative: Dropping 4 calendar days to P/U 3 or less calendar days.
- If TI pairings of longer duration, like 5 or 6 calendar days operate in the future, the same logic as above applies.

✓ **Holiday Restrictions:**

Holiday Daily Limits apply when a pairing being dropped contains a restricted Holiday duty period. Refer to page 10-27 of the LUS 2013 CBA.

- If the RF pairing/position and the dropped line pairing both contain a DP touching the same restricted Holiday, such transaction will be considered Neutral for purposes of Holiday restrictions. In this instance, Neutral transactions will be awarded if all other RF bidding criteria are satisfied.
- Conversely, if the restricted Holiday drop increases the open time limit on the restricted Holiday beyond the limit for such Holiday, the bid will be denied.

## Rules for RF with “Month to Month” Activity

---

**L/H RF Rules  
Month to  
Month RF  
Criteria**

✓ **Overlap Conditions:**

Under the provisions of LUS 2013 CBA 10.H., RF pairings/positions shall not commence a duty period on more than one day of the original pairing requested to be dropped. As previously stated, ISAP is not programmed to accept RF pairings; therefore the UBL is utilized to cover Red Flag pairings for L/Hs. The examples below comply with the intent of the CBA language and the workaround UBL procedures.

## Allowable “Month to Month” Activity

### Example 7 P/U-Drop

Current Bid Month: 01AUG thru 30AUG

Next Bid Month: 31AUG thru 30SEP

In the AUG bid month, F/A John has 85 hrs. with a 95 MAX.

In the SEP bid month, John is scheduled for 92 hrs. with a MAX of 115.

Scenario: John wants to P/U a RF pairing that originates in AUG and releases in SEP and drop a line pairing that originates in the SEP bid month.

## Allowable “Month to Month” Activity, Continued

**Example 8**  
**P/U-Drop**

Current Bid Month: 01AUG thru 30AUG

Next Bid Month: 31AUG thru 30SEP

In the AUG bid month, F/A Joey has 80 hrs. with a 95 MAX.

In the SEP bid month Joey is scheduled for 44 hrs. with a MAX of 95.

Scenario: Joey wants to P/U a RF pairing that originates in AUG and releases in SEP and drop a line pairing that originates and releases in the SEP bid month.

## Allowable “Month to Month” Activity, Continued

### Example 9 P/U-Drop

Current Bid Month: 01AUG thru 30AUG

Next Bid Month: 31AUG thru 30SEP

In the AUG bid month, F/A Tina has 70 hrs. with a 95 MAX; in the SEP bid month Tina is scheduled for 89 hrs. with a MAX of 95.

Scenario: Tina wants to P/U a RF pairing that originates and releases in AUG and drop two line pairings; one on the last day of the bid month and one pairing on the first of the following bid month.

<b>Result: DENIED</b>	<p>Tina’s transaction involves a 1-day pairing which touches the RF pairing on 30AUG. This is a positive bid in AUG and a negative bid in SEP. This pairing is not subject to any dropping limitations. However, the second 1-day pairing originating on 31AUG is in the next bid month and does not touch the RF pairing and is subject to Monthly and Daily limitations. Therefore, the transaction would be denied by Crew Scheduling because the pairing on 31AUG exceeds the Monthly and Daily limits.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> In many cases, a UBL transaction will only work by dropping one pairing because of the rule relating to not more than one day overlapping (commencing). However, in Tina’s case it was for another reason all together. Refer back to example 6 whereby dropping two 1-day pairings was approved.</p> <p>Furthermore, if this same UBL transaction (in example 9) was submitted to Crew Scheduling using a non-RF P/U and Drop(s) request, it would also be denied.</p>
