AA Flight Attendants Elect National Leaders

Eules, TX (February 27) – The Association of Professional Flight Attendants (APFA), representing the nearly 19,000 flight attendants at American Airlines, announced the results of its national officer run-off election yesterday as certified by outside accounting firm Whitley Penn and Associates. Laura Glading, New York-based flight attendant, along with her running mates Brett Durkin (current Vice President and Los Angeles-based flight attendant), Denise Pointer (Dallas based flight attendant) and Juan Barrera (Miami-based flight attendant) were elected to serve a four-year term beginning April 1, 2008.

Glading, who currently serves on the Executive Committee for the Union was also a lead negotiator during the 2000-2001 contract negotiations resulting in APFA's industry-leading contract, which was overwhelmingly ratified by the flight attendants on September 12, 2001.

APFA's current president, Tommie Hutto-Blake, along with Secretary Greg Hildreth and Treasurer Cathy Lukensmeyer did not seek reelection.
