## **APFA Praises Flight 31 Flight Attendants for Putting Passenger Safety First**

Eules, TX - The Association of Professional Flight Attendants praised Flight Attendants for their quick action on the successful evacuation of American Airlines Flight 31 after an emergency landing following reports of smoke and fumes in the cabin.

“The safety of our passengers comes first,” said APFA President Laura Glading. “We praise the exemplary performance of our Flight Attendants on Flight 31.”

“Our members, acted as they are trained to do in an emergency and their actions should not be called into doubt,” Glading said. “Investigations into any such incident are routine and expected.

“The safety of the flying public rightfully depends on Flight Attendants and the successful outcome of this evacuation is a tribute to our members’ skills and training. They should be praised for their quick and appropriate response.”
