## **American Flight Attendant Union Announces Protest Dates**

*Colossal Executive Bonuses Spur Nationwide Concern*

**Eules, TX (April 4, 2007)** - The Association of Professional Flight Attendants (APFA) has announced its plans to protest the upcoming AMR senior executive bonuses scheduled for payout this month. National events will be kicked off at the union headquarters in Eules, Texas on Friday, April 13 and will be followed by nation-wide flight attendant informational protest picketing events on Tuesday, April 17 at all American Airlines flight attendant bases in the system.

“These events give all American Airlines flight attendants an opportunity to speak out against senior management’s poor judgment to reward 874 executives with colossal bonuses upwards of \$200 million while the rest of us continue to sacrifice every day. These protests are to remind AMR executives that we all shared in the pain and will not stand by silently while only management’s elite rewards themselves with the fruits of our labor,” said APFA President Tommie L. Hutto-Blake.

American Airlines flight attendant bases are located in: San Francisco, Los Angeles, Dallas, Chicago, Washington D. C., Boston, St. Louis, Raleigh-Durham, New York and Miami.
