We still have the shortcomings of PBS, TTS and ROTA that remain contractually non-compliant. Discipline remains the company motto to deal with real problems.

I believe American can do better and your union can do better, with everything that has happened this past year, you deserve better. For the last two years I have worked with a great team here in Charlotte. The team of Hazlewood and Cagle are asking for your support, together we can move this union forward.
