PERSONAL STATEMENT:

As your VP and Base Council Representative, I will give a voice to working class flight attendants who are too junior to qualify for 70-hour paid LOAs, but too senior to have been furloughed. Even (most) furloughed FAs were eligible for furlough pay, unemployment and CARES Act pay. It might seem like it's a sweet spot to NOT have been furloughed, but the reality is shorter layovers, 4-legs-a-day trips with two-hour sits in between flights and prolonged potential exposure to COVID on packed flights have left a sour taste in our mouths. Our sacrifices have kept this company flying and our sacrifices should get more consideration going forward, especially in contract negotiations. I have worked at least 100 hours every month since I became a FA in 2013. Probably we have flown together and have the same concerns. I work to elevate the experience for our passengers every flight.
